STEPHEN: Two people are being exited from this office.

BEAT.

MARK: That so.

STEPHEN: Two.

MARK: That so.

STEPHEN NODS.

STEPHEN: Don't you want to know who?

MARK: Not really.

STEPHEN: Not a little bit curious?

MARK: Not really.

BEAT.

STEPHEN: The first one is Morris.

MARK: Don't know him.

STEPHEN: Marketing.

BEAT.

MARK: And the other?

STEPHEN: Thought you weren't interested.

MARK: You've tempted me.

STEPHEN: Windshuttle.

BEAT.

MARK: Windshuttle?

STEPHEN: Finance. Don't know him.

BEAT.
